



BASIC GUIDELINES FOR REFERRALS

Who We Serve:

Single moms, ages 20 and older, with children in their custody no older than 10. No extreme cases of mental illness, recent drug addictions or recent domestic violence. Must have a HS diploma/GED, have a car and pass a criminal background check.

Mission:

The purpose of Shiloh Place is to impact lives of single mothers through: housing, education, parenting, financial training, and spiritual and emotional growth.

Services Offered:

Our ministry provides housing, childcare and tuition assistance up to two years for a single mother and her children. Moms, in partnership with Case Management, set goals in various areas and outline steps needed to achieve goals. Case Management ensures that each woman has access to the resources needed as well as holds each resident accountable to the plan created. Other aspects of the ministry include: weekly professional counseling sessions, mandatory Life Skill classes (subject matters include Parenting, Financial Management, Forgiveness, Boundaries, Resume Writing, Interview Skills, etc.), financial planning and accountability.

Resident Expectations:

Participate in weekly Case Management, Counseling, and Life Skills classes, be actively engaged in a degree or certificate program, work part-time in your anticipated field, actively participate in achieving established goals, and be open to attending Bible study and Church services. Treat their children, staff, volunteers and other residents with respect. Have an attitude of gratitude and a teachable spirit throughout their time at Shiloh Place.

Length of Stay:

Shiloh Place is a transitional housing program where moms and their children can live up to two years; however once a mom reaches her goals and finds her long term job, then they will transition sooner.

How to Refer: Potential resident should call 214-218-0336 to complete an initial screening over the phone. The admission process takes approximately 3-4 weeks. **We are not equipped for emergency shelter or placement.**
